

2012 Incline Middle School Science and Engineering Fair will be held on Wednesday, February 15, 2012

IMPORTANT: BEFORE YOU BEGIN YOUR PROJECT YOU MUST FILL OUT AN ENTRY FORM AND READ THE SAFETY REGULATIONS.

LOCAL SCIENTIFIC REVIEW COMMITTEE APPROVAL FORM - (Entry Form)

1. Each student should fill out this form before they start their project, and it is required for both the IMS and the Regional Fair. This form must be turned in to your science teacher no later than **February 1, 2012** in order to qualify for the IMS fair. Your science teacher will sign and then it must go to the office, where it must be approved. One copy will be returned to the teacher and one copy will be returned to the student. Teachers must also select Physical Science, Life Science, or Invention in addition to signing each form. This is an official form required by the regional fair and it must be taped to the back left panel (left looking at the front) of the display in order to be judged at either Science Fair. IMS will use this regional form as the entry form.

You can find this form at the official Western Nevada Science and Engineering Fair website, or at the Incline Schools Website. Print page two. You will not need page one. Your science teacher may have printed copies.

2. Before you start, you must also **read and follow** the Western Nevada Regional Science and Engineering Fair Display and Safety Regulations. This is a one page form and you can simply go to the link above and then click on Display and Safety Regulations, or you can also find this form at Inlineschools.org. In addition your science teacher may have a printed copy.

Three Final Notes:

1. In addition to the rules above, no projects involving animals or humans are allowed at IMS.
2. IMS will not allow any names or faces on the front of the board. Both are allowed at the regional fair, but if either is on your board at the IMS fair, they must be covered so our judges will not see who did what project.
3. Team project and invention rules are on the Regional Website. In addition, IMS will not allow any team projects unless all team members have the same science teacher at IMS.
